





IMPERIALISM

What are the four reasons why European nations started exploring and colonizing new lands around the world?

1. The Ottoman Empire blocked the Silk Road, a trade route from India that provided Europeans with spices, in 1453.
2. Europeans wanted more wealth. Natural Resources, like gold and spices, helped European economies become very wealthy.
3. Claim new lands. By claiming new lands, Europeans gained nationalism and honor.
4. Spread of Christianity

England (England, Scotland, and Wales)	John Cabot	 <p>Examples: Canada, 13 Colonies of the USA, Australia, New Zealand, India, Malaysia, Pakistan, Egypt, Israel, Jordan, Nigeria, Uganda, and many others</p>	Early 1500s - Late 1900s
France	Jacques Cartier	 <p>Examples: French Guiana, Haiti, Western Africa, Tunisia, Cambodia, Vietnam</p>	Early 1500s - Late 1900s
